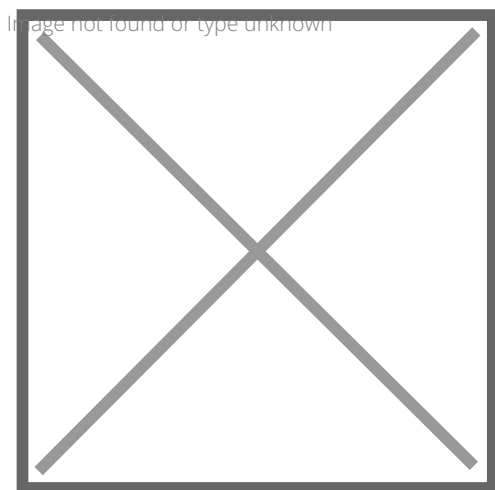

Killed in Action on the 09/10/1917 at the Battle of Poelcapelle (part of the 3rd Battles of Ypres/Passchendaele), age 27. Son of Denis and Mary McHugh of 3 Third Corgary, Aghyaran, Castlederg, Co. Tyrone. From the 1911 Ireland Census - Address - 3 Third Corgary, Castlederg, Co. Tyrone - Denis McHugh aged 60, Mary Anne McHugh aged 51, Denis McHugh aged 27, Mary Anne McHugh aged 25, Catherine McHugh aged 23, Margaret Ellen McHugh aged 21, James Joseph McHugh aged 19, Bridget McHugh aged 16, Cecily McHugh aged 13. James' Pension was awarded to his mother Mary and father Denis on the 30/04/1918 and the 01/01/1919. Employment was No data
