Killed in Action on the 12/07/1915 at the Battle of Achi Baba Nullah, Gallipoli, age 26. Son of William (1868 - 1934) and Margaret McLean. Husband of Margaret (01/01/1894 -) and Father of Jeanie (12/06/1913 -). From the 1901 Ireland Census - Address - 161 Ahoghill Village, Ahoghill, Antrim - Margaret McClean aged 29, Samuel McLean aged 12, Mary Jane McLean aged 7, Sarah McClean aged 5, James McLean aged 4, Elizabeth McClean aged 2, William John McClean aged 8 months (see photos). Samuel's Pension was awarded to his wife Margaret on the 21/02/1916. She remarried Sapper William Brown (91849) of the Royal Engineers on the 11/08/1916. Samuel and Margaret's daughter Jeanie is also listed on the Pension Record. Employment was Miner in Clarkston
