Killed in Action on the 31/07/1918 at Fampoux, age 22 / DOB - 02/02/1896. Son of Peter Bisset (/10/1853 -) and Mary Ann Bisset (02/04/1855 - 09/10/1923) of 551 Mountain Avenue, Winnipeg, Manitoba, Canada previously Colt Terrace, Coatbridge and 27 Corsewall St, Coatbridge. Peter's father's children with Isabella Bisset (1854 -) - Margaret 'Maggie' Bisset (1876 -) Born - Old Monkland, William Bisset (1877 - 07/04/1916) Born - Old Monkland, Isabella 'Bella' Bisset (1881 -) Born - Old Monkland. Peter's father's children with Mary Bisset - James Bisset (1887 -) Born - Old Monkland, Jeanie 'Jane' Bisset(1889 -) Born - Old Monkland, Elizabeth Drummond 'Bessie' Bisset (1891 - 1961) Born - Old Monkland, Mary White Bisset (1893 - 1928) Born - Old Monkland, Peter Bisset (02/02/1896 - 31/07/1918) Born - Coatbridge. In his Will Peter left all his property and effects to his father. Peter's Pension was originally awarded to his father Peter of 720 Atlantic Avenue, Winnipeg, Manitoba, Canada. It was then awarded to his mother Mary Ann of 226 Swandon Road, Easterhouse, Scotland on the 27/07/1920. Employment was Clerk, MHS Mining Company, Winnipeg, Canada previously Lochrin Iron Works Office.
