Killed in Action on the 24/03/1918 at the actions at the Somme crossings (part of the 1st Battles of the Somme 1918), age 19 / DOB - 01/06/1898. Only child of Peter and Isabella Paterson MacMillan of 1 Browns St, Coatbridge. John's father Peter died a short time before he left for the front. From the 1901 Census - Address - 5f Brown St, Coatbridge - Peter McMillan aged 32, Bella McMillan aged 35, John McMillan aged 2, Bella McMillan aged 11 months. John's Pension was awarded to his mother Isabella. Employment was John was about to enter Glasgow University
