Royal Navy H.M.S. "Colleen" Service No: 283414

Died of Heart Disease on the 07/04/1916 aboard H.M.S. "Colleen", age 38 / DOB - 01/09/1877. Son of Peter B Bisset and Mary Bisset of 27 Corsewall St, Coatbridge. Older half-brother of Lance Corporal Peter Bisset of the 78th Battalion Canadian Infantry who was Killed in Action on the 31/07/1918. William's father's children with Isabella Bisset - Margaret 'Maggie' Bisset (1876–) Born - about 1876 • Old Monkland, William Bisset (1877–07/04/1916) Born - 01/09/1877 • Old Monkland, Isabella 'Bella' Bisset (1881–) Born - about 1881 • Old Monkland. William's father's children with Mary Bisset - James Bisset (1887–) Born - Dec 1887 • Old Monkland, Jeanie 'Jane' Bisset (1889–) Born - about 1889 • Old Monkland, Elizabeth Drummond 'Bessie' Bisset (1891–1961) Born - Dec 1891 • Old Monkland, Mary White Bisset (1893–1928) Born - about Feb 1893 • Old Monkland, Peter Bisset (02/02/1896–31/07/1918) Born - Feb 1896 • Coatbridge. William's Pension was listed as awarded to his father Peter on the 23/09/1918 but was refused. The reason being 'entitlement not admitted'. Employment was Royal Navy from 17/09/1896 / Boilermaker
