Killed in Action on the 25/09/1915 on the opening day of the Battle of Loos, age 24 / DOB - 26/07/1891. Son of William and Mary Ann Docherty McTaggart of 93 High St, Rothesay, Bute. William's brother Gunner John McTaggart (300489) of the Royal Garrison Artillery, 4th Highland Mountain Brigade Died of Wounds at the 52nd General Hospital in Salonika on the 19/10/1918 and is buried at Mikra British Cemetery (561), Kalamaria, Greece. William had 2 other younger brothers, George (who was serving) and Thomas. He also had a sister named Agnes. Employment was Baker in the Dividend Stores, Airdrie
