



Private Hugh O'Neil (O'Neill)

1st Battalion King's Own Scottish Borderers Service No: 18967

Killed in Action on the 22/08/1915 at the Battle of Scimitar Hill, Suvla, Gallipoli, age 36 / DOB - 13/12/1878. Son of John and Mary Boyle O'Neil of 68a Coats St, Coatbridge then 17b East Canal St, Coatbridge. From the 1891 Census - Address - 3 Long Row, Coatbridge - Margaret McMlendin aged 65, boarders John O'Neil aged 36, Mary O'Neil aged 35, Hugh O'Neil aged 13, Edward O'Neil aged 11, Mary O'Neil aged 8, Patrick O'Neil aged 6, John O'Neil aged 4, William O'Neil aged 1. From the 1901 Census - Address - 18 East Canal St, Coatbridge - John O'Neil aged 48, Mary O'Neil aged 46, Hugh O'Neil aged 22, Edward O'Neil aged 21, Patrick O'Neil aged 17, John O'Neil aged 14, William O'Neil aged 11. Hugh's Pension was awarded to his mother Mary on the 08/07/1916. Employment was Iron Worker in the Victoria Iron Works
