



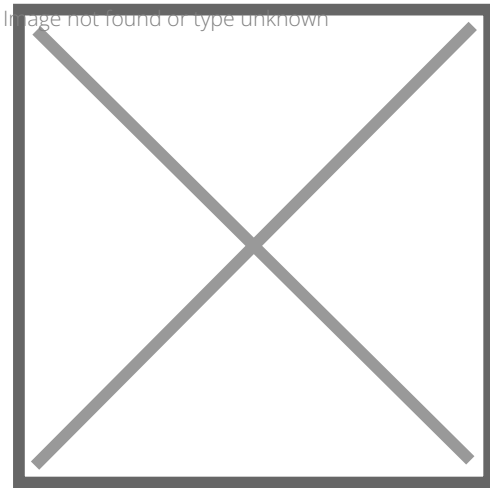

Killed in Action on the 10/05/1915 at the Battle of Frezenberg (part of the Battles of Ypres, 2nd Ypres), age 30. Son of Hamilton Park. Husband of Janet Park of 31 Back Row, Rosehall, Coatbridge. Father of 4 children, Jane Hamilton Park born 05/02/1908, Agnes McBlane Park born 02/02/1910, Ellen McDowall Park born 06/06/1911 and Maggie Park born 13/03/1914. From the 1891 Census - Address - Woodbine Cottage, Ayrshire - Thomas McEwen aged 69, Margaret McEwen aged 69, Hamilton Park aged 35, Hamilton Park aged 8, Alexander Park aged 4 (father and 2 sons living with Hamilton's mothers parents). From the 1901 Census - Address - 74 Pitt St, Cambuslang - Matthew Ryans aged 26, Catherine Ryans aged 22, Mary Ryans aged 3, Matilda Ryans aged 1, boarders Hamilton Park aged 17, William Fowler aged 18. Hamilton's Pension was awarded to his wife Janet on the 10/01/1916. Their 4 children are also listed. Employment was Rosehall Colliery
