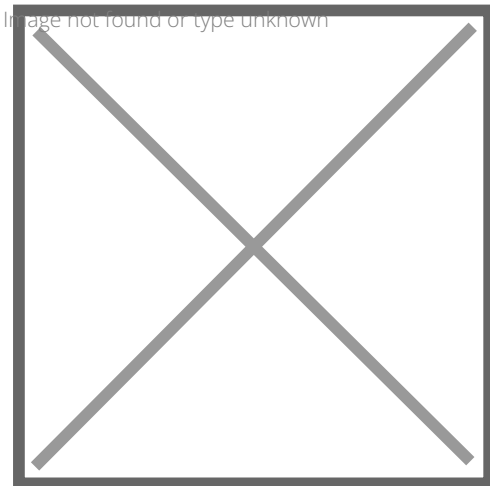

David Cairns Penman

**Royal Garrison Artillery 24th Trench Mortar Battery
Service No: 39863**

Killed in Action on the 17/06/1915 near Ypres, age 25 . Son of William Penman and Catherine Cairns Penman of Espieside Cottage, off Townhead Rd, Coatbridge. William died at home on the 04/02/1917 aged 69. From the 1891 Census - Address - 13 Tennent St, Coatbridge - William Penman aged 43, Catherine Penman aged 40, Margaret Linton Penman aged 19, William Penman aged 17, Alexander Cairns Penman aged 16, Robert Penman aged 2, David Cairns Penman aged 4 months. From the 1901 Census - Address - 15 Tennent St, Coatbridge - William Penman aged 53, Catherine Penman aged 51, William Penman aged 27, Alexander Penman aged 26, Robert Penman aged 12, David Penman aged 10. David's Pension was awarded to his mother Catherine on the 12/05/1919. Employment was Shingler in the Victoria Iron Works / Regular Soldier
