Died on the 09/12/1917 of peritonitis at the 45th Casualty Clearing Station in Achiet-le-Grand, age 22. Son of Mary Price and Charles Price of Coatbridge. William's mother Mary remarried Joseph Cairns after the death of William's father. William's sister Mary inserted William's death notice in the Advertiser on the 22/12/1917. William made an undated Will leaving the whole of his property and effects to his sister. The 1901 Census - Address - 108 Whifflet St, Coatbridge - Joseph Cairns aged 28, Mary Cairns aged 24, Lizzy Cairns aged 4, Mary Price aged, William Price aged 6. William's Pension was awarded to his sister Mary on the 16/08/1918. Employment was Barman with Mrs McBreerty, Main St
