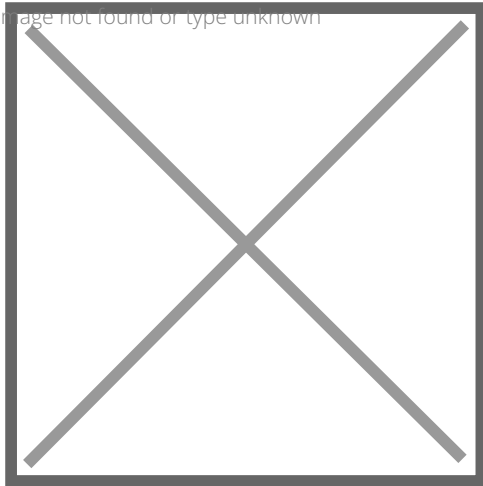

Killed in Action on the 27/04/1916 at the village of Hulloch., age 20. Son of the late Mr and Mrs James Purdie. From the 1911 Ireland Census - Address - 12 Synge St, Dublin - Anne Purdie aged 74, George Purdie aged 35, George Purdie aged 16, Anne Purdie aged 18, Elizabeth Purdie aged 27, boarders Daniel Sweeney aged 22, William Palmer aged 22. George and Anne listed as nephew and niece of Anne Purdie. They were born in Monaghan. George's Pension was awarded to his Aunt Lena Belton of 22 Grantham St, South Circular Rd, Dublin. Employment was British Tube Works
