



Private Alexander Russell Rankin

7th (Service) Battalion Cameron Highlanders Service No: S/18029

Killed in Action on the 28/03/1918 at the 1st Battle of Arras 1918 (part of the 1st Battles of the Somme 1918), age 21. Son of Alexander (1857 - 1938) and Isabella Glass Rankin (1863 - 1948) of 23 Lugar St, Coatbridge. From the 1901 Census - Address - 55b North Church St, Coatbridge - Alexander Rankin aged 43, Isabella Rankin aged 36, Thomas Bird Rankin aged 9 (1891 - 1959), Laurence Glass Rankin aged 7 (1894 - 03/10/1949), Alexander Russell Rankin aged 3, boarder Henrietta Rankin aged 26. Alexander's sister Margaret was born in 1902. Alexander's Pension was awarded to his mother Isabella on the 08/07/1919. Alexander is listed as missing on his Pension Record. Employment was No data
