Died of Wounds on the 24/11/1917 received during the Battle of Nebi Samwil and El Jib, age 26 / DOB - 03/01/1891. Son of Michael and Bridget Wilson Rice of 14g Kirk St, Coatbridge. Husband of Mary Rice of 26j Sunnyside Rd, Coatbridge. Father of 3 children. From the 1891 Census - Address - 253 Herriotts Row, Coatbridge - Bridget Rice aged 21, James Rice aged 3 months, boarders Bernard Carr aged 50, Elizabeth Carr aged 45. James' Pension was awarded to his mother Bridget Rice and then to his wife Mary Rice. Mary remarried and became Mrs Mary Smith of 8 Calder Avenue, Whifflet, Coatbridge. Employment was Tube Worker in the British Tube Works
