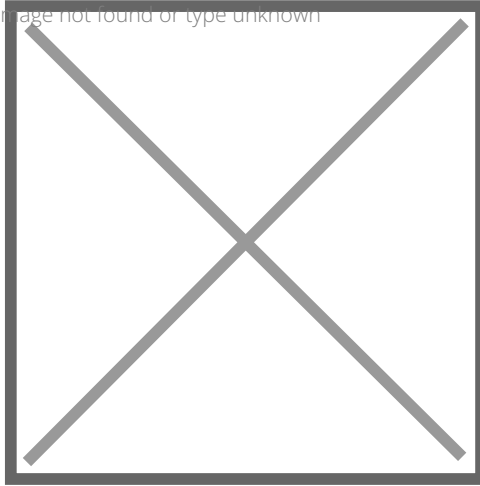

Killed in Action on the 07/06/1917 on the opening day of the Battle of Messines, age 20. Son of John and Elizabeth Boyle. From the 1901 Irish Census - Address - 56 Carrickbracken, Camlough, Armagh, Ireland - John Boyle aged 46, Elizabeth Boyle aged 45, James Boyle aged 20, Michael Boyle aged 18, Elizabeth Boyle aged 16, Mary Boyle aged 14, Bridget Boyle aged 13, Anne Boyle aged 8, Peter Boyle aged 5, Thomas Boyle aged 4. Thomas' sister Miss Lizzie (Elizabeth) Boyle received his belongings after his death. She was also awarded his Pension. Employment was Labourer at Langloan Chemical Works.
