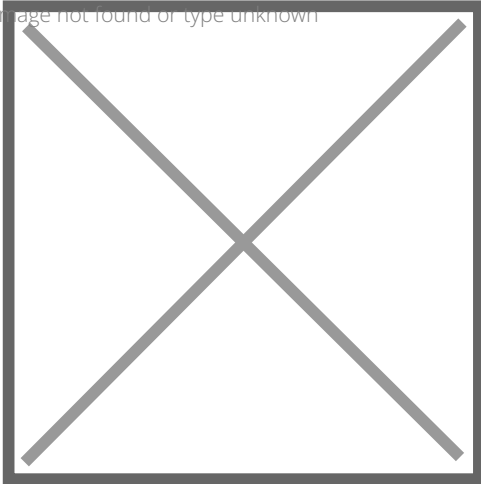

Killed in Action on the 11/01/1917 during the advance to the Hai and the capture of Khudaira Bend, age 26 / DOB - 07/01/1891. Son of Margaret Rodger of of 3 Langside Road, Bothwell. Nephew of Mrs Bell of Bothwell. In his Will dated 09/10/1916 Robert left the whole of his property and effects to his mother. Official news of Robert's death was sent to his aunt. From the 1891 Census - Address - Rosehall Pit No 11, Coatbridge - Robert's grandfather Andrew Rodger aged 66, Robert's grandmother Elizabeth Rodger aged 64, Robert's mother Margaret Rodger aged 25, grandfathers nieces Helen Bell aged 6, Margaret Bell aged 4, Bertha Rodger aged 1, Robert Rodger aged 3 months. Robert's Pension was awarded to his mother Margaret. Employment was Regular Soldier
