Died of Wounds on the 02/06/1915 in a Cairo Hospital. Wounds received to the cheek on the 16/05/1915 at Gallipoli, age 21 / DOB - 28/01/1894. Son of Terence and Bridget Rooney from Ireland. Brother of Pat and Ann Jane Rooney c/o Mrs McLeave of 311 Coats Pl, Main St, Coatbridge with whom he resided who received the news of his death. In his Will dated 25/04/1915 Terrence left the whole of his property and effects to his sister Ann Jane. From the 1901 Census (his father is listed as Farreman Rooney) - Address - 303b Coats Place, Main St, Coatbridge - Farreman Rooney aged 54, Pat J Rooney aged 26, Bridget Rooney aged 18, Margaret Rooney aged 14, Terrance (Terence) Rooney aged 7, Ann Jane Rooney aged 4. Terence's Pension was refused to his sister Ann Jane (see Pension Record 1). Employment was Stewarts and Lloyds Ltd
