Killed in Action on the 27/08/1916 at Longueval, Somme, age 19. Only son of John and Jessie of 58 King St, Coatbridge. Both parents died before John. His mother a few months before. John's sister inserted his death notice in the Airdrie and Coatbridge Advertiser on the 23/09/1916. From the 1901 Census - Address - 2 Coltswood Rd, Coatbridge - Jessie Smith aged 41, Lizzie Smith aged 9, Carrie Smith aged 7, John Smith aged 4 1/2, John's mothers niece Agnes Thomson aged 18. John's Pension was awarded to his sister Carrie Smith on the 25/03/1917. Employment was Accountant in Glasgow
