Killed in Action on the 25/09/1915 at Givenchy on the opening day of the Battle of Loos, age 23 / DOB - 04/03/1892. Oldest son of John and Elizabeth Casey Brennan of 25 Long Row, Gartsherrie, Coatbridge. From the 1901 Census - Address - 126 Long Row, Gartsherrie, Coatbridge - John Brennan aged 35, Eliza Brennan aged 30, Eliza Brennan aged 11, Patrick Brennan aged 9, Mary Ann Brennan aged 5, Kate Brennan aged 3, Bridget Brennan aged 1 and boarder Francis Casey aged 24. Patrick's Pension was awarded to his mother Elizabeth on the 03/01/1917. Employment was Iron Worker with William Baird and Co, Gartsherrie, Coatbridge.
