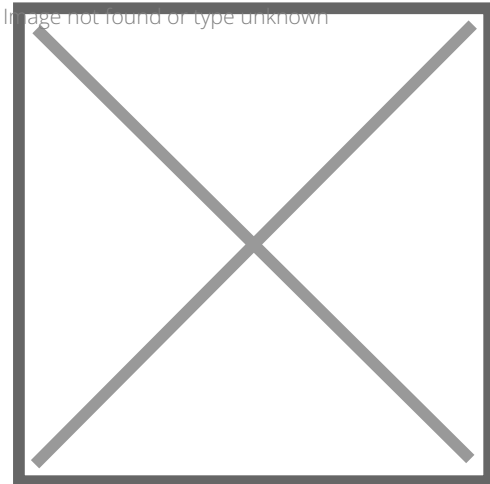

Charles Alfred Tedford

Killed in Action on the 25/04/1915 at the Battle of St Julien (part of the 2nd Battle of Ypres), age 29 / DOB - 02/12/1885. Son of Nicholas (1844 - 10/01/1920) and Ann Eliza Haire Tedford (1845 - 08/02/1893) of 15 Irwin St, Portadown. Parents were married on the 01/05/1867. Husband of Susan Sloan Tedford (18/06/1884 -) of 2 Bank Lane, Bank St, Coatbridge. Father of 3 children, Nicholas Tedford born 02/06/1909, Robert Sloan Tedford born 20/10/1911 and Charlotte Tedford born 12/11/1914. Charles never met his daughter. Charles' Pension was awarded to his wife Susan on the 22/11/1915. She remarried and became Susan McCormick. Employment was Tinsmith in the Tinplate Works, Whifflet and Woodside Ironworks / Reservist
