



## Able Seaman Henry (Harry) H Walker

## Royal Naval Volunteer Reserve "Nelson" Battalion Service No: Clyde Z/6439

Killed in Action on the 24/04/1917 at the 2nd Battle of the Scarpe (part of the Battle of Arras), age 24 / DOB - 29/04/1892. Son of Robert Walker of 1f Alexander St, Coatbridge. Henry's brother Able Seaman George Walker was wounded on the 28/04/1917. Another brother Private James Walker of the 6th Battalion Dragoon Guards contracted an illness in France and died in April 1916 whilst a 4th brother Oswald was serving with the Royal Inniskilling Fusiliers at the time of his death. Henry's next of kin was his sister Annie. Employment was Baker with William Brown and Company, Coatbridge
