



Private Edward Kerr

1st Battalion Royal Scots Fusiliers Service No: 48103

Killed in Action on the 22/08/1918 at Monchy-au-Bois during the Battle of Albert (phase of the 2nd Battles of the Somme), age 19. Son of Hugh and Catherine Kerr. From the 1901 Census - Address - 35 Dundyvan Rd, Coatbridge - Hugh Kerr aged 32, Catherine Kerr aged 29, Agnes Kerr aged 4, Edward Kerr aged 2, Elizabeth Kerr aged 9 months. Edward's Pension was awarded to his mother Catherine of 33b Dundyvan Rd, Coatbridge. Employment was British Tube Works
