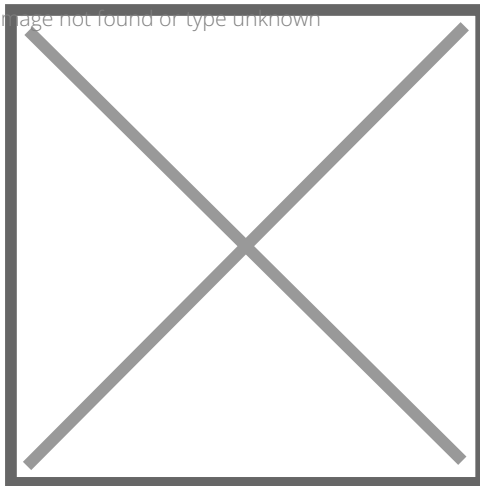

## **Theodore Byrne Gracie**

### **5th (Service) Battalion Royal Irish Fusiliers Service No: 15814**

Died at Home on the 16/02/1918 through sickness after being discharged on the 09/06/1916, age 36 / DOB - 16/09/1881. Son of Robert Murray Gracie and Mary Kilpatrick Gracie. Husband of Annie Fernie Gracie. They were married on the 31/03/1911 at Auburn Place, Parkhead, Glasgow. Father of Alexander Gracie born 21/04/1911, Mary Kirkpatrick Gracie born 06/05/1913 and Grace Gracie born 17/12/1914. From the 1881 Census - Address - Markethill, East Kilbride - Robert Gracie aged 32, Mary K. Gracie aged 26, James K. Gracie aged 4, Robert Gracie aged 2, Theodore B. Gracie aged 6 months. From the 1891 Census - Address - 68 Doncaster St - Robert Gracie aged 42, Mary Gracie aged 35, James Gracie aged 14, Robert Gracie aged 11, Theodore Gracie aged 9, Grace Gracie aged 6, Charlotte Gracie aged 6 months, Archibald Gracie aged 3. From the 1901 Census - Address - 3a Southburn Rd, New Monkland - Robert M. Gracie aged 51, Sarah J. Gracie aged 40, Theodore B. Gracie aged 20, Grace Gracie aged 15, Charlotte A. Gracie aged 10. Theodore's Pension was awarded to his wife Annie of 70p Buchanan St, Coatbridge. Employment was Tube Worker.
