Private William Brown

8th (Service) Battalion Royal Dublin Fusiliers "A" Company Service No: 16844

Killed in Action on the 27/04/1916 at the village of Hulloch, Loos, age 36. Brother of Mrs Bridget McGuinness of 42g Dunbeth Rd, Coatbridge. William came to Coatbridge with his sister Bridget in the early years of the century. He had 2 brothers serving in the Army, 1 with the Cameronians (Scottish Rifles) and the other with the Royal Inniskilling Fusiliers. From the 1901 Ireland Census - Address - 24 Castle High Street, Gilford, Co. Down - Henry Brown aged 69, Lizzie Brown aged 59, Bridget Brown aged 28, William Brown aged 21, Joseph H Brown aged 12. Employment was Tube Bender, Caledonian Tube Works.
