Killed in Action on the 27/04/1916 at the village of Hulloch, Loos, age 36 . Brother of Mrs Bridget McGuinness of 42g Dunbeth Rd, Coatbridge. William came to Coatbridge with his sister Bridget in the early years of the century. He had 2 brothers serving in the Army, 1 with the Cameronians (Scottish Rifles) and the other with the Royal Inniskilling Fusiliers. From the 1901 Ireland Census - Address - 24 Castle High Street, Gilford, Co. Down - Henry Brown aged 69, Lizzie Brown aged 59, Bridget Brown aged 28, William Brown aged 21, Joseph H Brown aged 12. Employment was Tube Bender, Caledonian Tube Works.
