Died of Wounds on the 06/11/1918 in the 16th Philadelphia Unit, USA General Hospital at Le Treport, age 19. Son of Thomas and Helen (Ellen) Bryce of 1h Colt Terrace, Coatbridge. From the 1901 Census - Address - 23 Crichton St, Coatbridge - Thomas Bryce aged 37, Helen Bryce aged 37, Christina Bryce aged 11, John Bryce aged 4, Thomas Bryce aged 3, Alexander Bryce aged 1. Alexander's Pension was awarded to his mother Ellen on the 13/05/1919 then to his father Thomas when his mother died. Employment was Labourer in the Victoria Iron Works.
